Please also bear in mind that a good river width for the sailing will always be appreciated, so where possible, please try to avoid double mooring (Waveney's excepted).

All camping and moorings must be pre-booked by completing one of these forms and email a scanned copy (or photo) to BecclesASC@gmail.com, You will be issued with a number and permission to camp once payment has been received.

Any tents without correct numbers visibly displayed may be removed.

Parents and guardians are responsible for their children (age under 18) at all times.

Please ensure that you know where your children are at all times, and do not allow them to play in the dinghy park area or on the veranda/veranda stairs attached to the clubhouse.

No campfires or bonfires to be lit anywhere on the site.

Noise is always to be kept to a reasonable level so not to annoy other members
